When I first used and observed the road in 1950, it followed the same route as in 2000 when I last observed it. Attached is a Beaver County map showing Copperking Mine Road. To the best of my knowledge and based upon my use of and familiarity with this road and the land it traverses, the location and route of the road are correctly illustrated on the attached map.

3. I am informed that the County also identifies this road according to the road number listed above.

4. I have observed that the road has been open to the public for all to use, to come and go as they pleased, since at least as early as 1950 and continuing through 1976 to 2000. 


8. Prior to 1976, I observed the graded surface of the road.


