AFFIDAVIT OF RICHARD D. ROCK

Richard D. Rock, being first duly sworn, deposes and states as follows:

1. I am an adult competent to testify about the matters set forth below based upon my personal knowledge. I currently reside in Box Elder County, Utah. I have lived in Box Elder County 65 years. I have worked for the Box Elder County Road Department since 1963 and my father had worked for the road department many years before I started.

2. I have traveled and am familiar with a road in Box Elder County known as Hardister Road. I am also familiar with the land the road traverses. When I first used and observed the road in the early 1960s, it followed the same route as in 2004 when I last observed it. Attached is a Box Elder County map showing Hardister Road. To the best of my knowledge and based upon my use of and familiarity with this road and the land it traverses, the location and route of the road are correctly illustrated on the attached map. The County also identifies this road according to the road number listed above.

3. I have observed that the road has been open to the public for all to use, to come and go as they pleased, since at least as early as the early 1960s and continuing through 1976 to 2004. Throughout this time period I have observed travel on the road by various means, including cars and trucks and all types of motor vehicles. Throughout this time period, the road has been used weekly for more than ten continuous years prior to 1976, and is presently used weekly.

4. Throughout the time period from the early 1960s to 2004, I have used the road myself for county road work and hunting.

5. Throughout the time period described in the previous paragraph, I observed vehicles using the road at various times for the uses described in the previous paragraph, plus ranching and traveling in and through the area. This road is used by ranchers to access ranch lands across the Nevada border. It also continues on to the town of Jackpot, Nevada.


6. It is also the reputation in the community that this road has been open to the public for all to use, to come and go as they pleased, since at least as early as the early 1960s and continuing through 1976 to the present, for the uses described in the previous paragraphs.

7. The road has been maintained up to the Nevada line by the county since at least the early 1960s. The road has been graded since the early 1960s and the county has continued to maintain it regularly through the present.

John Collom, being first duly sworn, deposes and states as follows:

1. I am an adult competent to testify about the matters set forth below based upon my personal knowledge. I currently reside in Box Elder County, Utah. I have been the Box Elder County Road Supervisor from 1983 to the present. I have been employed by the Box Elder County Road Department since 1961.

2. I have traveled, worked on and am familiar with a road in Box Elder County known as Hardister Road. I am also familiar with the land the road traverses. When I first used and observed the road in the early 1960s, it followed the same route as in 2006 when I last observed it. Attached is a Box Elder County map showing Hardister Road. To the best of my knowledge and based upon my use of and familiarity with this road and the land it traverses, the location and route of the road are correctly illustrated on the attached map. The County also identifies this road according to the road number listed above.

3. I have observed that the road has been open to the public for all to use, to come and go as they pleased, since at least as early as 1962 and continuing through 1976 to the present. Throughout this time period I have observed travel on the road by motor vehicles. Throughout this time period, the road has been used numerous times during the week with year-round access. It was used continuously for more than ten years prior to 1976.

4. Throughout the time period from 1961 to the present, I have traveled the road in my capacity as a Box Elder County road employee.

5. Throughout the time period described in the previous paragraph I have observed vehicles using the road at various times for ranching, hunting and traveling in and through the area. This is an old ranch road that has been used for many years to reach ranches across the Nevada border.






