TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME, Greeting:

Know ye, This is an Acknowledgment and Notice of Acknowledgment made under Utah Code Sections 72-5-309 through 310 inclusive, that the grant of the United States of America of "the right of way for the construction of highways over public lands, not reserved for public uses" under United States Revised Statutes 2477 (43 U.S.C. Section 932 (repealed October 21, 1976, with proviso recognizing the validity of rights-of-way already established)) was accepted for and on behalf of the State of Utah and its political subdivision Sanpete County as it pertains to the highway located in Sanpete County known as OLD 132 ROAD; County Road Number: Sanp166; State Geographic Information Database (SGID) Road Identification Number: RD200074. Total road length is 5.05 miles more or less.

The reason for this Acknowledgment and Notice of Acknowledgment includes, but is not limited to, the fact that the road was constructed, mechanically, or by continuous use as a public highway for a period of at least ten years, over public lands not reserved for public uses, prior to the earlier of (a) the October 21, 1976 repeal of R.S. 2477 or (b) the date the servient estate was reserved for public uses.

This Acknowledgment and Notice of Acknowledgment applies only to the segments of the road that traverse land owned by the Bureau of Land Management, United States Department of the Interior, and does not apply to segments of the road that traverse land owned by any other person or entity. The State of Utah and its political subdivisions reserve the right to make further acknowledgments and notices of acknowledgment with regard to road segments that traverse land owned by other entities, including the United States of America, through one or more of its agencies.

A printed copy of a map showing the location of the road in said county is appended hereto as "Attachment 1," a printed copy of representative photos of the road is appended hereto as "Attachment 2," a printed copy of a description of the beginning and ending points of the entire road together with a list of Townships, Ranges and Sections that may be traversed by the road in said county is appended hereto as "Attachment 3," and a printed copy of the Road Centerline Description Cover Page(s) is appended hereto as "Attachment 4." The Appendices listed in "Attachment 4" that contain the actual road centerline descriptions are incorporated herein by reference. Affidavits provided by individuals familiar with the road are appended hereto as "Attachment 5."

A printed copy of this Acknowledgment and Notice of Acknowledgment, together with its Attachments and Appendices, may be viewed and/or obtained at the office of the Utah State Archives.

An electronic copy of this Acknowledgment and Notice of Acknowledgment, together with its Attachments and Appendices, may be viewed and/or downloaded as read-only PDF (Portable Document Format) files via the



Any of such agencies or any other person with a servient ownership claim or a competing dominant estate right-of-way ownership claim, may file a petition in the State District Court for Salt Lake County for a decision regarding the correctness of this Acknowledgment. A claimant shall file a petition within sixty (60) days after receipt of this Notice.







CARL POULSEN, being first duly sworn, deposes and states as follows:

1. I am an adult competent to testify about the matters set forth below based upon my personal knowledge. I currently reside in Manti, Sanpete County, Utah. I have lived in Sanpete County for 86 years.

2. I have traveled and am familiar with a road in Sanpete County known as Old 132 Road. I am also familiar with the land the road traverses. When I first used and observed the road in 1930s, it followed the same route as in 2007 when I last observed it. Attached is a Sanpete County map showing Old 132 Road. To the best of my knowledge and based upon my use of and familiarity with this road and the land it traverses, the location and route of the road are correctly illustrated on the attached map. I am informed that the County also identifies this road according to the road number listed above.

3. I have observed that the road has been open to the public for all to use, to come and go as they pleased, since at least as early as the 1930s and continuing through 1976 to 2007. Throughout this time period I have observed travel on the road by various means, including cars, pickup trucks, jeeps, sheep wagons, and cattle trucks. Throughout this time period, the road was used daily.

4. Throughout the time period from the 1930s to 2007, I have used the road myself for trapping, hunting, camping, snowmobiling, and travel through area to Nephi.

5. Throughout the time period described in the previous paragraph, I observed vehicles using the road at various times for the uses described in the previous paragraph, plus sheep and cattle herding and wood gathering.



7. Prior to 1976, I observed signs that the road had been maintained. The road has had an asphalt surface since before 1976.




RICHARD OLSEN, being first duly sworn, deposes and states as follows:

1. I am an adult competent to testify about the matters set forth below based upon my personal knowledge. I currently reside in Manti, Sanpete County, Utah. I have lived in Sanpete County 74 years. I worked as County Road Supervisor for the Sanpete County Road Department from 1967 continuing through 1979, and then returned again to the same position from 1987 to 1995.
2. I have traveled and am familiar with a road in Sanpete County known as Old 132 Road. I am also familiar with the land the road traverses. When I first used and observed the road in 1936, it followed the same route as in 2007 when I last observed it. Attached is a Sanpete County map showing Old 132 Road. To the best of my knowledge and based upon my use of and familiarity with this road and the land it traverses, the location and route of the road are correctly illustrated on the attached map. The County also identifies this road according to the road number listed above.
3. I have observed that the road has been open to the public for all to use, to come and go as they pleased, since at least as early as 1936 and continuing through 1976 to 2007. Throughout this time period I have observed travel on the road by various means, including cars, trucks, semi-trailer trucks, cattle trucks, sheep wagons, ATVs, and road construction equipment. Throughout this time period, the road was used daily.

4. Throughout the time period from 1936 to 2007, I have used the road myself for performing road maintenance with the Sanpete County Road Department, plowed snow occasionally, and for personal travel.

5. Throughout the time period described in the previous paragraph, I observed vehicles using the road at various times for the uses described in the previous paragraph, plus sheep and cattle herding, a travel through area, residential access, private land access, and recreation such as hunting, camping, snowmobiling, and ATV riding.


6. It is also the reputation in the community that this road has been open to the public for all to use, to come and go as they pleased, since at least as early as the late 1800s and continuing through 1976 to the present, for the uses described in the previous paragraphs.

7. Prior to 1976, I supervised and observed county road construction and road maintenance equipment being used to grade and maintain road, repair pot holes, and plow snow. The road has been paved since before 1976.





The following description is based upon the geographic coordinate system using the NAD83 Datum. The source is GPS mapping grade data as indicated in the metadata and/or the transportation data model of the State of Utah Geographic Information Database (SGID).

The road-segment itself is the monument that is identified by its physical presence on the land. The location of said physical presence is closely approximated by mapping grade Global Positioning System (GPS) data. Said data are checked against the corresponding gray-scale 1-meter Digital Orthophoto Quadrangles published by the United States Geological Survey (USGS) to verify a reasonable degree of accuracy. In circumstances where accurate satellite signal acquisition is not possible, such as deep, narrow canyons or under a canopy of dense foliage, or where very sharp curves in the road make accuracy questionable, such portions of the road were digitized from the corresponding gray-scale 1-meter Digital Orthophoto Quadrangles published by the United States Geological Survey (USGS).
