



GILBERT BROUGH, being first duly sworn, deposes and states as follows:

1. I am an adult competent to testify about the matters set forth below based upon my personal knowledge. I currently reside in Vernal, Uintah County, Utah. I have lived in Uintah County 72 years.

2. I have traveled and am familiar with a road in Uintah County known as Wyasket Bottom Road. I am also familiar with the land the road traverses. When I first used and observed the road in the 1940's, it followed the same route as in 2003, when I last observed it. Attached is a Uintah County map showing Wyasket Bottom Road. To the best of my knowledge and based upon my use of and familiarity with this road and the land it traverses, the location and route of the road are correctly illustrated on the attached map.

3. I am informed that the County identifies this road according to the road number described above.

4. I have observed that the road has been open to the public for all to use, to come and go as they pleased, since at least as early as 1948 and continuing through 2003. During this time period I have observed travel on the road by pickup trucks. During this time period, the road has been used weekly and more lately daily.

5. During the time period described above, I used the road myself for the following uses: mining, oil and gas exploration and development, fishing and hunting.

6. During the time period described in the previous paragraph, I observed vehicles using the road at various times for the uses described in the previous paragraph, plus the following uses: farming and livestock operations.







2. I have traveled and am familiar with a road in Uintah County known as Wyasket Bottom Road. I am also familiar with the land the road traverses. When I first used and observed the road in 1934, it followed the same route as in 1995, when I last observed it. Attached is a Uintah County map showing Wyasket Bottom Road. To the best of my knowledge and based upon my use of and familiarity with this road and the land it traverses, the location and route of the road are correctly illustrated on the attached map.

3. I am informed that the County identifies this road according to the road number described above.

4. I have observed that the road has been open to the public for all to use, to come and go as they pleased, since at least as early as 1934 and continuing through 1976 to 1995. During this time period I have observed travel on the road by various means, including pick up trucks, horses and Dad's Model T Ford. During this time period, the road has been used daily.

5. During the time period from 1934 to the 1995, I have used the road myself for traveling in and through the area and hunting.

6. During the time period described in the previous paragraph, I observed vehicles using the road at various times for the use described in the previous paragraph plus the following uses: fishing, recreation farming, livestock operations, oil and gas exploration and development, hunting and predator control.

7. It is also the reputation in the community that this road has been open to the public for all to use, to come and go as they pleased, since at least as early as 1934 and continuing through 1976 to the present, for the uses described in the previous paragraphs.




