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Summary of Survey Responses for Counties in the Six County Association of Governments

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Introduction

The materials included in this appendix are intended to supplement information presented in *Public Lands and Utah Communities: A Statewide Survey of Utah Residents*, a report submitted previously to the Utah Public Lands Coordination Office. That report presented an analysis of results from a 2007 statewide survey of Utah residents conducted by Utah State University that was designed to assess ways in which social and economic conditions across the state may be influenced by public lands and the use and management of natural resources which those lands contain.

The findings presented in the initial project summary report were based on comparisons across eleven multi-county geographic clusters located throughout the state, with each cluster comprised of two to four adjoining counties. In response to requests from local government and public agency officials, we have developed a series of supplemental appendices (Appendices C.1 through C.7) that expand upon the analyses presented in the earlier report and provide an overview of survey response patterns for the groups of counties included in each of Utah's seven multi-county Associations of Government (AOGs). Previously we also prepared appendices for each of Utah's twenty-nine counties (Appendices B.1 through B.29), along with an appendix summarizing overall statewide response patterns (Appendix B.30). The original project report, along with all of these supplemental appendices, are accessible on the "library" page of the Utah Public Lands Coordination web site (<http://governor.utah.gov/publiclands/library.htm>).

This Appendix (C.4) focuses on survey results obtained for the six counties (Juab, Millard, Piute, Sanpete, Sevier and Wayne) included in the Six County Association of Governments. As was outlined in the original project report, self-completion questionnaires were distributed during April through June, 2007 to random samples of residential household mailing addresses in all Utah counties. Details regarding survey administration procedures and response rates for all 29 counties are available in the project summary report. The results presented here, which are based on responses of survey participants from each of the counties included in the Bear River AOG, have been statistically weighted to adjust for variations in sample sizes relative to the populations of each of these counties, thereby insuring that the combined results are accurately representative of the area-wide population.

The pages that follow contain tables summarizing the ways in which survey participants responded to nearly all of the items included in the survey questionnaire. Tables are presented in the same sequence that questions appeared in the questionnaire, and numbered in a fashion that corresponds to the original question numbers. For example, the table labeled "Q1.3 Recreational activities: backpacking" corresponds to the third item included under question 1 in the survey questionnaire, which asked about respondents' participation in backpacking as a recreational activity on Utah's public lands. Similarly, the table labeled "Q15.4 Public land managers should reduce or increase extent of: exploration or development of oil and gas" corresponds to the fourth item in a series included under question 15 in the survey questionnaire. Table titles and response category labels should allow the reader to interpret the content presented in these tables fairly readily. A copy of the survey is attached after the tables to assist in the interpretation of the results.

In every table, the responses to individual questions are reported across each of the available response categories in three different ways: as the actual number of respondents who selected a particular response choice (the column labeled “frequency” in each table); as the percent of all survey participants within the county who selected a particular response choice (the column labeled “percent”), and as the percent of survey participants providing a valid answer to the question who selected a particular response choice (the column labeled “valid percent”). Survey participants who did not answer a question had a “NR – non-response” code assigned, and those who wrote in “don’t know” had a “DK” code assigned; both of these codes were designated as “missing response” and are not included in the “valid percent” calculations.

At the statewide level, the large number of survey participants (3,799) provides for a high degree of precision in estimating the attitudes, activity patterns, and characteristics of Utah residents based on responses to the survey questionnaire. At the level of individual counties the numbers of survey participants are considerably smaller, in some instances falling well below 100 total responses. Because of this, the results derived from survey response patterns for Association of Government areas in which sample sizes were low for individual counties must be interpreted with caution, since the potential for random sampling error to produce inaccurate estimates of population characteristics increases substantially when the number of cases in a sample is small. However, the grouping of several adjoining counties included within the various AOG boundaries produces results that are less likely to be affected by random error, due to the larger combined total number of responses.
